

ANDERSON PARK

W9978 792nd Street

PARK DESCRIPTION:

Anderson Park (phase #1) is a 2.849 acre Neighborhood park located in the center of the Andrus Sub-division at the end of 792nd Street (Anderson Street). Anderson Park is an open grassy area. Maple trees, spruce trees and sand cherry shrubs have been planted in the park. Ongoing development of the Park is in progress.

Prairie grass and wild flowers are proposed to be planted and a chipped trail created around the perimeter of the park.

Anderson Pathway is a 20 foot wide crushed rock path connecting 988th Street and 986th Street (Herbert Road).

SUMMER ACTIVITIES:

1. Hiking/walking, jogging.
2. Viewing the wild flower blooms.
3. Bird watching.

WINTER ACTIVITIES:

1. Hiking/walking/jogging.
2. Cross Country skiing/snow shoeing.

DIRECTIONS FROM DOWN TOWN RIVER FALLS:

Anderson Park is located in the center of Andrus Sub-division. The sub-division is location at the South East corner of State Highway #29 and Happy Valley Road in the Town of River Falls.

MAIN ENTRANCE-792nd Avenue:

From Downtown River Falls travel South on Main Street which turns into South Main Street which is also State Highway #29. Approximately one mile past Cemetery Road you will come to the intersection of State Highway #29 and 770th Avenue (Happy Valley Road), turn left (East), about ¼ mile turn right on 988th Street. You have now entered Andrus sub-division. Proceed about ¼ mile turn right onto 792nd Avenue (Anderson Avenue), this road will end in a cul-de-sac, look for Anderson Park sign.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS BEING CONSIDERED:

- Wood chip trail creating a loop through the park.
- Plant prairie grasses and wild flowers.
- Add Bird and Bat houses to the park.
- Add picnic tables to the park.
- Additional trees will be planted.

FUTURE PARK IMPROVEMENTS:

In the future, as the Andrus sub-division progresses into phase #2, an additional 2.25 acres will be add to Anderson Park bring its total to 5.10 acres.
